Abortion Access: The Future of Roe v. Wade

After a decades-long assault on the right to abortion, a leaked opinion has confirmed our worst fears: **that the Supreme Court is preparing to overturn Roe v. Wade**.

To be clear, the leaked opinion is a draft. Abortion is still a constitutional right. But the language of the draft leaves no question about what the end goal is and creates a blueprint for unraveling rights we have fought so hard to protect.

If the Supreme Court moves forward with overturning Roe, 26 states would likely move to ban abortion – including 13 states with laws that could immediately go into effect. In half of the country, people would no longer have power over their own bodies and their own lives. This includes 36 million women, trans people, and non-binary people of reproductive age who can become pregnant.



State abortion bans will primarily impact people with low incomes, who are disproportionately Black, Latino, Indigenous, and other people of color. That's because wealthy people will always have the resources to get the care they need.

As devastating as that would be, returning this issue to the states is not the end goal for the anti-abortion movement. Anti-abortion politicians have set their sights on a nationwide abortion ban that would block abortion access in every state in the country.

The leaked opinion takes aim at other hard-fought rights, including your right to marry who you love and your right to use birth control.

California is a reproductive freedom state and we are fighting to ensure it stays that way. There are 13 bills

moving through the California legislature right now to protect and expand access to reproductive health care, and Planned Parenthood and our partners are working on a ballot initiative to solidify the right to abortion in our state constitution.

In preparation for this decision, we have already hired more nurses, more doctors, and we've opened a sixth health center, to ensure that we can provide as much care as we can, to as many people as possible. We're working to provide travel and logistical support to patients traveling to our Central Coast health centers from other states.

An overwhelming majority of the public stands with us and supports the Roe v. Wade decision. On May 14th, over one million people participated in 450 Bans off our Bodies rallies - including three along the Central Coast.

During this dark moment, we want to reassure you that Planned Parenthood California Central Coast <u>is not</u> going anywhere. We will not back down. With your continued support, we're doubling down.

We have been doing this work for over 100 years, and we will never stop fighting until all people have the freedom and the power to control their own body and life.

Investing In Our Future

At Planned Parenthood, we are working toward improving health outcomes, and reducing health disparities. Climate change is a health equity issue because it can worsen existing health disparities due to pollution, poor living conditions, racism, other forms of discrimination, and psychological stress.

Climate change also directly impacts reproductive health because climate-related disasters make it harder for people to access health care and increases the need for contraception and abortion.

Here is how PPCCC is taking action to address the climate crisis this year:

- Our new strategic plan centers our commitment to health equity, which includes climate mitigation, adaptation, and resilience.
- We are reducing the energy and water footprints at all our facilities. Two of our six health centers transitioned to solar energy this year and we are planning to add a third. We will also add an electric car charging station at our Ventura Health Center.
- We worked with Direct Relief to secure grant funding to add battery back-up power at our health centers, which will make our centers more climate resilient, even in the face of natural disasters.
- Our public affairs team worked with partners to oppose Exxon's trucking proposal for Santa Barbara County, which was defeated by the Board of Supervisors.
- We stood with environmental justice organizations like CAUSE and MICOP to confront systemic racism and demand environmental justice to secure protections for people most impacted by dangerous agricultural pesticides, including people living in agricultural regions and farmworkers.

Largest Single Gift in Planned Parenthood History






