A Letter from Sita & Staci

Dear Planned Parenthood Southeast family:

This past year tested our strength and resiliency like never before. Through the COVID-19 pandemic, national uprisings against police brutality and racism, and continued attacks on our reproductive health and rights, our lives and our communities have been impacted in some of the most significant ways. This year, we've all seen fear. But we also know hope. We felt anger. But then we mobilized into action.

Despite the daily challenges, PPSE has remained resolute in this fight because it's who we are, and what our patients and supporters deserve. We have focused our efforts on strengthening our partnerships and innovating our systems to keep our team and our patients safe from the pandemic. We also redouble our commitment to hearing from all voices: our patients, our employees, our supporters, and the communities we serve.

This moment calls for us to act boldly and to show up in this work prepared to do the hard things. We continue to push forward because we believe that those most vulnerable in our communities deserve protection and defense. 2021 has given us our first real glimpse of what a world without Roe could soon look like for millions of people across the south and beyond. In response, we rallied in solidarity with patients, providers, and advocates to demand that our leaders repeal restrictions and pass protections to make abortion more accessible.

At the same time, the staff at our health centers were busy serving more patients than ever before through both our in-clinic and telehealth service options. Our education team joined the national chat/text team, allowing us to assist hundreds of young people looking for medically-accurate, expert support for their sexual and reproductive health questions.

This year has affirmed what we always knew, that Planned Parenthood is essential.

Our movement is strong because our mission is clear. Despite the efforts of those who oppose abortion and our organization, we will never stop fighting to ensure that all people can access high-quality reproductive health care – no matter what. None of the work we do would be possible without our team who has demonstrated sheer grit and determination in the face of so much uncertainty over the past twelve months.

As we look ahead, we are energized by the power of this movement. We look forward to a day when our bodies are our own and a world where every person feels seen, heard, loved, and celebrated. But make no mistake, it's going to take all of us working together to get there.

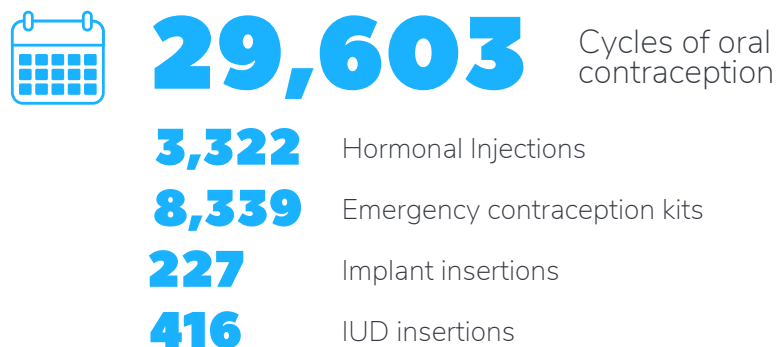

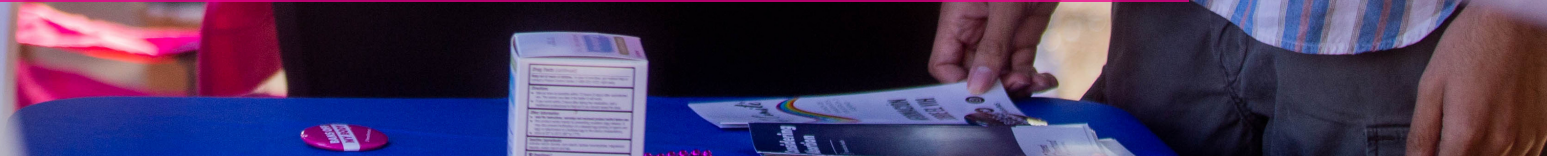

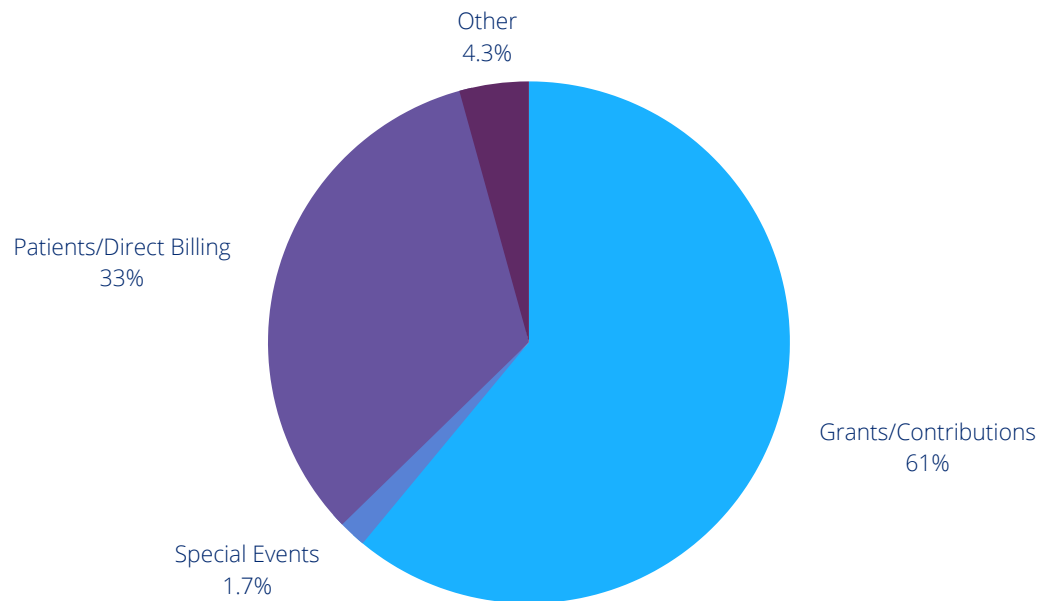


Abortion Justice Speakout rally in Jackson, MS

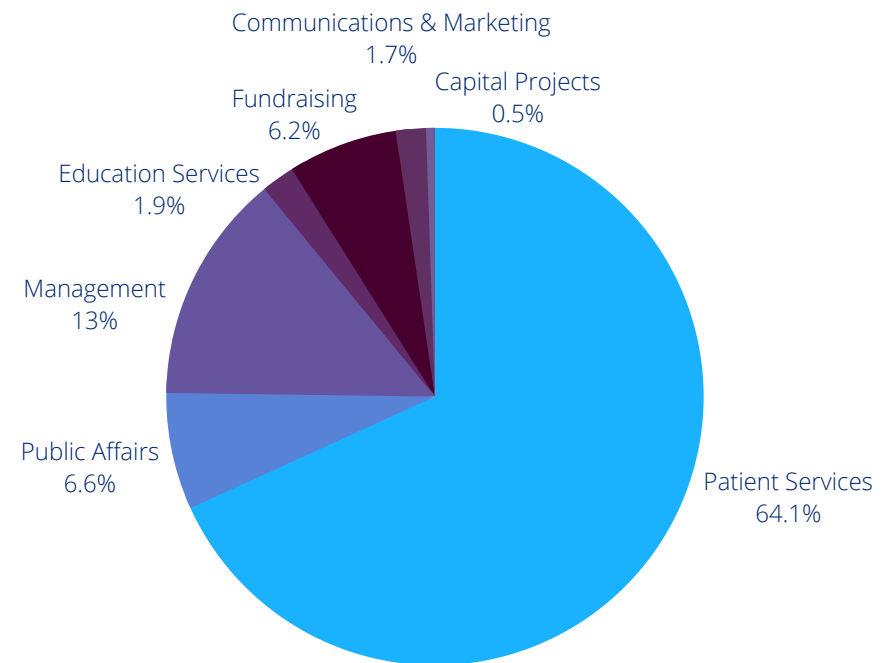


FINANCIAL OVERVIEW FOR FY 2020-2021
