Patient's Rights and Responsibilities

As one of our patients, you have choices, rights, and responsibilities.

Patients' Rights:

- 1. To be treated with dignity and respect.
- 2. To receive information about the services and costs.
- 3. To be introduced to the people serving you.
- 4. To know that what you say will be confidential.
- 5. To know that your privacy will be respected.
- 6. To receive explanations for the service performed.
- 7. To receive answers to your questions.
- 8. To review your medical records.
- 9. To consent to or refuse any care or treatment.
- 10.To request testing for STD's or other lab tests we offer.
- 11.To request or refuse a clinician.
- 12.To have your needs addressed.
- 13. To be free from neglect; exploitation; and verbal, mental, physical or sexual abuse.

Family Planning patients also have the right to:

- 1. Decide whether and when to have children.
- 2. Know the effectiveness, possible side effects and problems of all methods of birth control or treatments prescribed.
- 3. Participate in the selection of a birth control method, lab tests, and treatments that we offer.
- 4. Opt against, change, or discontinue receiving family planning services at any time.

You have the responsibility to:

- 1. Give accurate information about your medical history.
- 2. Make certain that you understand all instructions.
- 3. Follow health care advice and medical instructions.
- 4. Report any changes in the condition of your health.
- 5. Honor your appointments or give 24 hours' notice before cancellations.
- 6. Pay for services you received.

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
