## **Position Summary**

The Health Center Support Volunteer performs various tasks within our health centers to assist our clinical staff in providing excellent service to our community. The Health Center Support Volunteer ensures that health centers are cleaned, stocked, and contain necessary documents and supplies for patients. The Health Center Support Volunteer upholds PPCW's Values and Service Standards and improves the overall operations of the health center.

#### **Essential Functions**

#### **Cleaning:**

- Use infection prevention techniques
- Clean, restock, and organize exam rooms
- Clean instruments, tools, and lab

#### **Inventory:**

- Unpack, match, count, and put away inventory received
- Organize and restock informational brochure display
- Assemble patient education packets, safer sex kits, and other materials
- Organize and restock supplies in exam rooms and providers' medical drawers

### **Administrative:**

- Sign up for available volunteer shifts
- Track and record volunteer hours on a weekly basis
- Maintain open communication with supervisor

### Qualifications, Competencies, and Skills

#### **Required Qualifications:**

- Willingness to learn, adapt, and complete tasks as needed by health center staff
- Ability to work and communicate well with a diverse staff
- Proficiency in PCs, Microsoft Office, and general office equipment
- Must be able to provide or complete the following medical records/tests prior to volunteering in health center:
  - o Negative Tuberculosis (TB) screening within the last 12 months
  - o Rubella immunity or 2 vaccination dates
  - o Hepatitis B immunity or 3 vaccination dates
  - COVID-19 vaccination or proof of exemption for medical or religious reasons

## **Preferred Qualifications:**

- Experience working in healthcare settings
- Experience working in stressful or demanding situations

• Interest in non-profit sexual and reproductive healthcare

# **Physical Requirements:**

- Ability to volunteer at least two 2-hour shifts per month for 6 months
- Ability to move supplies weighing up to 20 LBS
- Must be able to remain in a stationary position for extended periods of time
- Transport self to and from health center for volunteer shift
