We will expand our educational programs to help youth develop leadership abilities and develop the skills they need to take charge of their reproductive lives.









■ ≤ 100% of *FPL—54%


■ 101 - 200% of *FPL—25%

≥ 201% of *FPL—21%



Interns and Volunteers

Throughout 2021 we had many amazing interns and volunteers. Our North Country affiliate had over 1,235 volunteer and/or intern hours. Our Watertown interns conducted a Community Needs assessment throughout our six county service area and presented their findings to PPNCNY leadership. The assessment has allowed us to target communities in need of PPNCNY services and collaborate with other community partners to integrate these services to more folks living in our service area. Interns and volunteers also help accomplish various "in house" tasks and projects. Many volunteers completed hours by being escorts for patients into our health centers, as well as making safe sex kits. We are beyond grateful for out interns and volunteers and are always open to fresh minds and new ideas to help our patients and communities.

Advocacy, Outreach & Education

PPNCNY's Education and Outreach staff provided 366 trainings with teachers and community health workers, while providing education to 3,541 people and outreach to over 4,000 through the 2021 pandemic

Sexual Assault Services











In 2021, Planned Parenthood's Sexual Assault team educated 2,162 students on sexual assault prevention. We served over 119 women, children and men with 384 calls to our toll free 24 hour hotline (1-877-212-2323). Our hotline is served by 15 trained volunteers who provided 8,736 hours of volunteer service. We counsel victims of sexual assault and provide survivor kits to rape victims at the hospital. Our staff also escorts survivors to the police station and/or courthouse.

Rape: The victim knows the perpetrator 80% of the time.

Child Sexual Abuse: The child knows the abuser 93% of the time.

College Campus: The victim knows

the perpetrator **90%** of the time.
